ECD Level 4 (SAQA ID 97542) refers to the Occupational Certificate: Early Childhood Development Practitioner, a registered South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) qualification. It is a 15-month qualification course for preschool teachers, day mothers, and teaching assistants for children aged 0-4. This qualification replaces the legacy L4 ECD qualification and is now the new standard for ECD practitioners in South Africa. It is designed for practitioners who work with children from birth to five years old and aims to develop their skills and knowledge to provide quality care and education.

Requirements to complete the course:

- Monthly compulsory online facilitated sessions. (A second support session is optional)
- Monthly practical contact sessions with preschool learners at an approved ECD Centre. (Evidence to be submitted online)
- Assessment of theoretical and practical assignments determining competency. This includes a:
 - Knowledge Component
 - Practical Skills Component
 - Workplace Experience Component
- The completion of an External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) at the end of the course for certification.

Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive a SAQA-accredited QCTO National Certificate. This certificate will grant you access to partial ECD SACE registration as an Early Childhood Development Practitioner. Additionally, there will be a formal online graduation ceremony to celebrate your achievements.

At the end of your studies, you will receive the following:

1. A completion certificate from Eduexperts
2. A Statement of Results
3. EISA Registration Notification
4. QCTO/SETA Certificate
5. Invitation to an Online Graduation Ceremony
6. SACE Registration Guidance

Answers to Frequently Asked Questions:

- A mandatory Comprehension Test will determine your English competency. Success in this Comprehension Test will affirm your acceptance into the ECD L4 course.
